## Reflecting on God's Word

1. Read **John 21**.
2. Recall specific episodes in your life when you asked God, "Why me?" What was the specific question you were asking? What was your attitude in asking? What kind of response did you want? What kind of response did you get?
3. In vv. 15-23, find as many clues as you can that Jesus was personally and specifically dealing with Peter, rather than Christians in general.
4. Do you believe that Jesus wants things in your life unique to you? Why do you have that view?
5. Do you expect to discover the Lord's will more by a "seated conversation" or a "walking conversation"?
6. In prayer, commit yourself to walk with Him and to allow Him to reveal to you what His personal will is for you over time.
