Get to know Him

*The Holy Spirit is our **most direct relationship** with God.*

The Spirit is **100% God**

He is **spirit**
... allow His **breath** to move you

He is a member of the **Trinity**
... **directly experience** God

He is especially **present** in the Church Age
... be an **active member** of His Church

He is **perfect and holy**
... the only way to **become holy**

He **knows the mind** of the Father
... we must **be fully known** by Him

He is **everywhere**
... you don't need **experience**

He is the **unstoppable power** of the Church
... open yourself up to His **power**

He has **always been**
... He must **first indwell** you

The Spirit **relates** to the Father and to the Son

He **carries out** the Father's will

... we will **obey** by the power of the One who **carries out** the Father's will

He is Jesus' **biggest fan**

... we will **glorify Christ** by the power of the One who **glorifies** Him

The Spirit **relates** to us

He is **personal**

... relating to Him will be **personal**

He is our **connection** to God's Word

... relating to Him will be in **partnership** with the Word

He is our **Comforter**

... relating to Him will be **emotional and spiritual**

He is the **power** of the Christian life

... relating to Him will be **energizing**

He is the **main "do-er"**

... relating to Him will be ... **continued next week!**
